Medical Backup

Although you do not need to be medically referred to The Hearing Care Centre, with your consent we like to keep your family doctor fully informed. If we detect a potentially medically treatable condition during your assessment, we can easily arrange for the appropriate medical follow-up.



Three steps to better hearing

Assessment – this includes an audiometric hearing test together with various procedures to evaluate your ability to hear speech in noisy environments, with a full discussion of your particular areas of hearing difficulty.

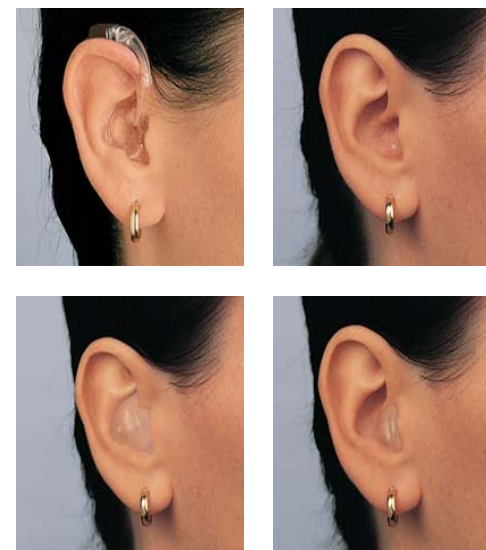
Fitting – when your hearing aid fitting is ready, you will be given full instructions on how to make best use of it, and how to get used to being part of the hearing world again.

Follow up – after you have been using your hearing aid for a few weeks, we ask you to come back for a check-up - just to make sure that all is well and to make any tuning adjustments.

Charges
